- 4.1 To establish maintain run, develop & improve schools, colleges, industrial and technical institutes and computer studies and the medical colleges, academic institution and other institutions and to promote generally educational and cultural knowledge and activities.
- 4.2 To establish maintain, run, develop and improve Nursery, Primary, Secondary, Sr. Secondary, Higher Secondary Schools, Commercial, Industrial, Technical, Physical, Online Coaching, Offline Coaching and all or any other kind of education.
- 4.3 To impart education to children and for the purpose to all acts that may be necessary.
- 4.4 To hold, arrange and organize meetings, lectures, talks, discussions, seminars, symposia, conferences, competitions, research and study visits, tours, excursions, exhibitions, debates, cinema, audio-visual programmes, the artistic performances and other cultural activities sports and games.
- 4.5 Establishment, maintenance and support of libraries, museums and reading rooms and distribution of books etc. for advancement of education and knowledge in general.
- 4.6 Advancement and propagation of education and learning including establishment maintenance and support of schools, college, pathashalas and other educational Institutions, auditoriums, lectureship professorship, scholarship and prizes etc.
- 4.7 Advancement of any other object of general public utility and relief like conducting seminars on educational advancement providing necessary assistance during natural calamities and such other assistance as may be required from time to time.
- 4.8 To create awareness in Trust about social evils through contacts, meetings, classrooms training etc.

- 4.20 To conduct research studies on the social a economic conditions or people with a view to involving ways and means for their development with in their social historical frame works and to seek promotion of rural development such as provision of drinking water rural industrialization as well as Public Convenience for people.
- 4.21 To explore ways for promotion of socioeconomic development in the community.
- 4.22 To undertake, organize, conduct and facilitate, Courses, conference, lecture, research and education on various aspects and of science, technology, trust and other fields.
- 4.23 To train the downtrodden people in general for human resource development in views of the emerging needs such as database development, resource survey methodologies, computer, environmental, studies, health education, and energy problems.
- 4.24 To undertake and promote the publication & translation of journal, research papers and books and to develop the audiovisual programme to disseminate knowledge pertaining to the objectives of the trust.
- 4.25 To work for the welfare of trust neglected and martingales people.
- 4.26 To protest and fight against the injustice against people.
- 4.27 To encourage and promote family welfareactivities among needy people.
- 4.28 To aid or establish any institution technical or otherwise, to promote education of art, Science or other related fields for the benefit of downtrodden and weaker sanctions of the trust.
- 4.29 To arrange and provide medical aid and other assistance necessary for living to the needy people who are incapable or handicapped or mentally/physically retarded and financially unfit.

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- 4.30 To start and assist the relief measures in those parts of the country which become effected to natural calamities like farina, fire flood, earthquakes etc.
- 4.31 To communicate and coordinate with the Govt., Local and public authorities on various issues related to development welfare and Public interest on different subjects.
- 4.32 To construct, maintain, alter, improve or develop and building belonging to the trust or works necessary or convenient for purpose of the trust.
- 4.33 To arrange/ establish and maintain centers of adult education, vocational education technical training low cost educational, format & non-formal education.
- 4.34 To fight against HIV/AIDS and other communicable diseases.
- 4.35 To aware people about various social issues to fight against evils.
- 4.36 To issue appeals raise funds and accept gifts, donation subscriptions in cash or in kind and any property either movable or immovable for the achievement of the objective of the trust.
- 4.37 To acquire, purchase or otherwise own or under take on loan or lease or hire temporary or permanently and movable or immovable property necessary or convenient for the furtherance of the objects of the trust.
- 4.38 To organize and take-up Health, Educational and Welfare programmes for needy & poor women & Children.
- 4.39 To promote and protect Indian Traditional music, dance, handicraft, handlooms, Art. Modern art & literature.
- 4.40 To support the families and relatives of artists for promoting the budding artists in the trust.
- 4.41 To establish an award for the deserving people in the field of Music. Art grass root level social service, communal harmony, brotherhood and peace.
- 4.42 To encourage the emerging artists and their talents so that they can get proper recognition within and beyond the country.
- 4.43 To establish centers(s) for the promotion of Music, Dance and other Arts.
- 4.44 To establish residential and non-residential cultural centers for promoting Music, Dance and other Arts.
- 4.45 To work for Environmental, Protection, Forestation, plantation, Waste Land management.
- 4.46 To organize vocational training for women and needy people.
- 4.47 To organize awareness camps, health camps, March, workshops, campaign and exhibition.
- 4.48 To aware people about their democratic & fundamental rights.
- 4.49 To promote cottage industries, Khadi, and traditional handicraft.
- 4.50 To advocate Panchayati Raj System among citizens.

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- 4.51 To provide various medical services such as organizing health and awareness camps of immunization, Eye Care, Motherhood, child care and communicable Diseases.
- 4.52 To prevent any epidemics and to advocate both permanent and temporary measures of Family planning.
- 4.53 To provide basic medical facility, sanitation, general health care and other needful support which can be helpful for public to overcome sufferings and agony of any natural and manmade disaster and to facilitate them to rehabilitate.
- 4.54 To provide medical, emotional, psychological, social and medical support to senior-citizens for our trust by setting up various drop-in centers. Senior citizen homes, old-age homes and other entertainment centers so that these highly honourable people should not be neglected.
- 4.55 To undertake activities for sensitizing people to preserve the natural resources of nation and to maintain the ecological balance of the area.
- 4.56 To provide and facilitate legal assistance to underprivileged and poor section of trust to fight for their rights and justice.
- 4.57 To promote, encourage and facilitate research programmes and trainings in the field of public health, education and empowerment.
- 4.58 To arrange and organize religious, social and cultural programmes for all human beings from time to time.
- 4.59 To create a sense of brotherhood, love, humanity, affection, cooperation and friendship amongst the members of the trust and the beneficiaries.
- 4.60 To make best efforts for promotion, development and protection of the beneficiaries/ target population and help them in distress.
- 4.61 To help poor, widows, handicapped, orphans, old aged, mentally retarted and under privileged section of the trust/community.
- 4.62 To run/operate different types of education programme, schools like formal, non-formal, preschool for the education development of under privileged children of the community/trust.
- 4.63 To run the different types of health programmes to raise the health status of vulnerable groups, poor and needy.
- 4.64 To work for the empowerment and sensitization of women, adolescents and children.
- 4.65 To make up efforts for the education, welfare and development of women, children and backward community in both urban and rural areas throughout the country.
- 4.66 To establish the medical facilities in the working locality (if required) such as family planning centers, dispensaries, hospitals etc.

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- 4.67 To run and open the schools for the welfare and uplift of the needy children and also run adult education programmes.
- 4.68 To publish books, magazines, charts, issue related IEC (Information, Education and Communication) materials and other periodical illustration for generating the income for the trust for the benefits of its aims.
- 4.69 To work and fight against discrimination based on Cast, Creed, Colour, Gender, Religion Faith Race & Nationality.
- 4.70 To open/run/manage institute/ collage of higher/ professional/ vocation education in any part of the country for providing quality education and training to youth and children.
- 4.71 To promote and protect natural herbs and plants by cultivation, preservation, storage processing, demonstration, creating botanical garden and providing necessary training.
- 4.72 To establish/run/manage hospitals, health centers, mobile health clinics, research center to provide health care, counseling and referral services for all kinds of illness and deceases.
- 4.73 To promote traditional therapies like Yoga, Naturopathy, Meditation, Acupressure, Acupuncture, Massage Therapy, Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Reiki etc.
- 4.74 To establish build or manage Hostels, Short Stay Homes, Rehabilitation Centers, Shelters, Creches, Child Care Centre or Children's Home, Counseling Centers and Help Line Centers for Women, Children, Old aged persons, Drug addicts and needy persons.
- 4.75 To work for the welfare of Agricultural workers, Farmers. Unorganized Labours. industrial labours and Migrated labours.
- 4.76 To form women groups, youth groups, self help groups; old aged groups, adolescent groups, children groups/clubs, community leaders groups and group of volunteers.
- 4.77 To promote traditional games along with the contemporary sports among youth & others.
- 4.78 To work for welfare & support for the families of Martyrs and Prisoners.
- 4.79 To work against the exploitation of Animals & Birds and make sincere efforts to protect them.
- 4.80 To celebrate annual day of the trust every year as cultural & social event.
- 4.81 To establish Citizen Forum (s) and Resident Welfare Association (s) for the development of high values of the Unity, Brotherhood, Communal Harmony and peace.
- 4.82 To promote and support voluntary donation of Blood, Eyes and other parts of Human body for the charitable purpose.
- 4.83 To take-up, initiate or assist social development activities or welfare programmes for bringing positive change in the lives of the common people.

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- 4.84 To save or protect National Heritage, Buildings or Places of the archeological & historic importance.
- 4.85 To spread the teachings & thoughts of great leaders, philosophers, thinkers reformers and saints.

All the incomes, earning, movable/ immovable properties of the trust shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its aims and objects only a set forth in the Memorandum of the trust and no profit, thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus. Profits or in any other manner whatsoever to the present or past members of the trust or to any person calming through any one or more of the past members. No member of the trust shall have any personal claim on any moveable or immovable properties of the trust or make any profits, whatsoever, by virtue of this membership.

- 05. AND GENERALLY to do in all public, charitable purposes for public benefit without any discrimination of Caste, Creed, Color, Gender, Religion, Faith, Race or any nationality. That in case any of the objects of the Trust are held to be non charitable within the meaning of section 2 (15) of the Indian Trust Act, or any statutory modification (s) thereof. The Trustee(s) shall not carry out such objectives.
- 06. The Trust shall be irrevocable and no part of the Trust Fund in any circumstances whatsoever shall be paid or applied for the benefit of the Settlor. If the Trust fails or is held to be invalid for any reasons whatsoever, it shall not result in any trust or benefit in favour of the Settlor and no part of the assets or property shall be transferred to the settler or trustee.

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## Power, Functions & Duties of the Governing Body:

- i. The governing body will be responsible for achieving the aims & objects of the Trust and shall work in the best interest of the Trust, for which it shall be empowered to deploy the funds & assets of the Trust for the stated objects.
- ii. The governing body will be competent to raise funds and purchase property movable and immovable on free-hold or lease basis in its name as decided by it.
- iii. The governing body shall have full charge of all immovable properties and moveable assets belonging to or vested in the Trust and these will be managed in such a manner as it considers appropriate subject to the overall control and directions of the general body of the Trust.
- iv. The governing body shall be competent to invest the funds in the manner it considers appropriate in the best interests of the Trust and it shall be competent to borrow or mortgage or hypothecate the properties on behalf of the Trust in the manner decided.
- v. To constitute various standing or adhoc committees for looking after such functions as my be assigned from time to time.
- vi. To create provision for engagement to regular or part-time employees of the Trust to look after the secretarial accounting and other functions in a seamless manner.
- vii. To outsource certain functions e.g. cleaning security and similar other maintenance activates of the premises of the Trust.
- viii. The governing body will be is the custodian of the assets of the Trust.

## Term and Mode or Election of Governing Body

a) The term of the governing body shall be for life time membership.

Power, functions & duties of the office-bearers:

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#### i. Chairman:

- a) To preside over all the meeting of the general body and of the governing body and regulate the proceedings of such meetings.
- b) To do all such acts. Deeds and things as may be authorized by the general body and or the governing body from time to time.
- c) To allow or disallow discussion on any matter which is not included in the agenda.
- d) To supervise and guide the overall actives achievement of aims & objectives of the Trust.

#### ii. Vice-Chairman:

- a) To assist the Chairman in carrying out his duties.
- b) In absence of the Chairman to act on his behalf and perform all duties and exercise all the powers of the Chairman.
- c) To do all such acts. Deeds and things as may be authorized by the governing body.

#### iii. Secretary:

- a) To conduct, Organize supervise and manage all the affairs of the Trust and do all such acts and perform all such duties for the working of the Trust as may be assigned by the Chairman governing body.
- b) To issue identity cards to the members.
- c) To convene meetings of the general body with the consent of the Chairman and serve proper notices.
- d) To attend all the meetings of the general body and the governing body and assist the Chairman in conducting the meeting and record proceedings of the meetings.

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- e) To prepare annual report of the Trusty and place it before the governing body along with audited annual accounts of the Trust for approval to place the same before the general body in the annual general meeting.
- f) To keep and preserve the records of the Trust/governing body.
- g) To help and assist the Chairman in looking after the complete affairs of the Trust and in attaining aims & Objects of the Trusts.
- h) To be the custodian for safe custody of common seals of the Trust and affix the same wherever required as per the authorization of the governing body.
- To conduct correspondence on behalf of the Trust governing body and to sign letters and papers on its behalf to ensure that all statutory registers and records are properly kept and maintained.
- j) To prepare before announcing of the date of election and the annual general meeting the list of all the member eligible to vote, duty updated and to place it before the governing body.
- k) The responsibility for convening the meetings of a Trust will be vest in the secretary of the Trust who will also be the custodian of all records documents title deeds etc. of the Trust unless otherwise provided in the byelaws.
- 1) Act as the overall in charge of the administration and execution of all the programme of the Trust including financial affairs on behalf of the governing body including creation of posts. Fixation of salaries remuneration allowances etc. make appointments engagement of staff make purchases and do all other such things as may be necessary in the furtherance of the aims & objects of the Trust in accordance with the delegations by the governing body from time to time and where on such delegation is specifically made in consultation with the Chairman of the Trust.

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#### iv. Treasurer:

- a) To keep accounts of all financial transactions of the Trust and of all the sums of money received and spent by the Trust and maintain records of receipts and expenses relating to such matters and of assets credits and liabilities.
- b) To get the accounts of the Trust audited by the chartered accountant appointed by the governing body at the close of the financially year every year.
- c) To submit to the governing body through secretary the audited annual accounts of the Trust at least one month prior to the date of annual general meeting.
- d) To act as the overall custodian of all the books of accounts statutory records and cheque books of all bank accounts FDRs. Etc of the Trust financial statements receipt books expense vouchers bank pass books & cheque books cash etc.

# 07. THE BOARD OF TRUSTREES SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING POWERS:

- 7.1 To manage the properties, assets and funds of the Trust, from time to time, such regulations (not being inconsistent with this deed) as they may think fit for and necessary for the purposes of such management and control or in connection with the execution of any of the subject herein contained or powers hereby vested in them and may rescind or alter any such regulation.
- 7.2 To accept donations, contributions, grants, subscription in cash or in kind from any person, company, firm, association, organizations, government, non-government or semi-government agencies, national or foreign funding agencies, family Trust, or corporate bodies for furtherance and achievement of the objectives of the Trust.
- 7.3 To appoint a managing Trustee, when necessary.
- 7.4 To review the affairs of the Trust and a necessary.
- 7.5 To appoint officers and members of staff for the Trust and to prescribe their condition of service.
- 7.6 To open and to provide for operating banking accounts.
- 7.7 To raise loans with or without security or to invite donation and financial help.

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- To receive the honorarium or salary against his/her services or involvement in any of the 7.8 project or programme run by the Trust, which must be decided by the Board of Trustees and approved by the Chairman / Chairperson.
- To authorize person (s) to sigh or execute documents on behalf of the Trust. 7.9
- To grant receipts for aid or donation received. 7.10
- To grant Special Power of Attorney to represent the Trustees in connection with any legal 7.11 or other proceedings.
- To acquire land or building on the lease or way of purchase. 7.12
- To compromise, compound or refer to Arbitration all actions, proceedings and disputes 7.13 relating to Trust property or properties.
- To sell or give on rent/lease or on hire any immovable or moveable property of the Trust 7.14 for some certain period (s) on such terms and conditions as the Trustees may think fit and proper from time to time.
- To open any type of bank account (s) weather saving account, current account, fixed or 7.15 otherwise, in the name of the Trust or institution (s) or programme (s) run by the Trust with any scheduled banks (s) or post office (s) and to operate by the authorized signatory or signatories as Board of Trustees shall think fit and proper to authorize any person or persons, unless and until determined otherwise the such bank account(s) shall be opened and operated jointly with signatures of any two members of Board of Trustees. The financial year for the Trust shall be from - and the accounts of Trust or institution (s) or programme (s) run by the Trust shall be audited yearly by the auditors (s) or Charted Accountant or a firm of charted accountants to be appointed by the Board of Trustees and the fee for auditor(s). if paid, shall be a part of outgoing amounts from the Trust Funds.
- To give guarantee of the assets and property of the Trust, including the bank guarantee on 7.16 behalf of the Trust to corporate bodies, persons. firms. institutions, as Trustees may decide from time to time. The Trustees shall not be personally liable for such guarantees or the securities.
- To gift, lease, and transfer the immovable and moveable properties of the Trust. 7.17
- To appoint lawyer, pleaders, advocated to file and defend suit or suits filed for and 7.18 against the Trust and or in the name of the Trust and also file suits for financial and other disputes or dues with different parties and signed executed such application, petition documents for such proceedings and delegate powers to the officers(s), employee(s), staff(s) and Trustee(s) for such proceedings(s) as required from time to time.

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- 7.19 To appoint new member or members of Board of Trustees by a resolution and to discharge any of the Trustee, who become bankrupt or acts in any manner prejudicial to the interest or objects of the Trust or is convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude, or becomes of unsound mind or is otherwise unfit to continue as Trustee, by resolution passed by simple majority of members present and voting in the meeting of Board of Trustees.
- 7.20 To appoint from time to time on such terms and conditions as they may determine a Secretary. Manager, Executive Director, Director(s) and other officer(s) or members(s) of staff for carrying out the activities of the Trust and to remove at any time any such Secretary, Manager. Executive Director. Director(s) and other officer(s) or members(s) of staff.
- 7.21 After defraying all necessary expenses incurred in the collection or realization of the income from the Trust ten percent (10%) of the balance of the income shall be kept in a reserve fund to be utilized when, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees, there is any emergency and the remaining income may be utilized for the purpose of the Trust.
- 7.22 The Trustees shall invest the Trust fund in government securities, saving certificates, fixed deposits or in any other form of investment authorized under provisions of INDIAN TRUST ACT and INDIAN INCOME TAX ACT, 1961, as they shall deem expedient.
- 7.23 It has further been decided that as and when the Trust is enclosed or dissolved all the funds of the Trust shall be transferred to the other recognized Public Charitable Trust having similar objectives.
- 7.24 All questions relating to the management of the Trust or the exercise of the powers vested in the Trust shall be decided at a meeting or, if necessary and expedient, by circulation. Every such question shall be decided by a majority of the Trustees present and voting in any meeting of Board of Trustees or by the circulation, as the case may be and any action or decision of such majority shall be as valid as if it was done or made by the all Trustees. The Chairman / Chairperson shall have a casting vote.
- 7.25 In case of occurrence of any vacancy amongst the Trustees because of death, resignation or incapacity of any Trustee or any other cause, a new Trustee may be appointed to fill the Vacancy.
- 7.26 All matters not provided for in this Trust deed but necessary for the administration of the Trust of for giving effect to the objectives of the Trust may by resolution(s) made by the Board of Trustees carried by full majority of all members of Trust.

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- All resolutions will be made by the full majority of the trustees. 7.27
- **<u>VOTING:</u>** Decisions of the Board of Trustees may be made at a meeting or by circulation 7.28 of papers to them. Normal matters of routine nature may be circulated and decision obtained. The important matters are to be decided at the meeting. All matters arising for disposal/all resolutions shall be decided by a majority of the Board of Trustees by all members voting.
- QUORUM: The Quorum for the Meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be full majority 7.29 quorum is required for a meeting adjourning for want of Quorum. All members signature required to fulfill the quorum.
